| Description: | <p>Summary: The UKCIP tool BACLIAT assesses the potential impacts of climate change, using a checklist. Target user groups are corporate or multi-facility operations and non-industrial SME business managers. The tool has been used in the UK, and applied to agriculture, building design and construction, motor manufacturing, and financial services sectors.</p>  <p style="text-align: right;">Placemark Link</p> <p>More information: The exercise results in a list of potential threats and opportunities from climate change under the six generic headings:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (1) <i>Logistics</i>: vulnerability of supply chain, utilities & transport infrastructure; (2) <i>Finance</i>: implications for investment, insurance & stakeholder reputation; (3) <i>Markets</i>: changing demand for goods & services; (4) <i>Process</i>: impacts on production processes & service delivery; (5) <i>People</i>: implications for workforce, customers & changing lifestyles; (6) <i>Premises</i>: impacts on building design, construction, maintenance & facilities management; Management implications. <p>BACLIAT puts less emphasis on cross-sectoral interactions, which would have to be derived by the users.</p> | |
